

## **FACULTY POSITION OPTICAL PHYSICS**

### **University of Oregon**

The University of Oregon Physics Department seeks to hire an Optical Physicist for a tenure-track or tenured faculty position at the rank of assistant or associate professor, to start in the 2006-2007 academic year. We encourage applications from those with strong records in theoretical optical physics, including those also having experimental programs. Areas of current research activity in the department include experimental and/or theoretical work in quantum optics, quantum information, semiconductor optics, cold atoms, ultrafast dynamics, photonic crystals, nanostructured materials. The position will carry membership in the Oregon Center for Optics, a university research center.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications, and start-up funds will be available. Applicants should have a Ph.D. in physics or a related discipline and an outstanding record of research accomplishments. Some prior teaching experience is also desirable. The successful candidate will be expected to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels and conduct a vigorous research program. Candidates should send a current curriculum vita, a list of publications, and a statement of current research interests and future research plans, and should arrange to have three letters of recommendation submitted to: Chair, Optics Search Committee, Department of Physics, University of Oregon, Eugene, OR 97403-1274.
