

The Centre for Quantum Computation at the University of Cambridge expects to have a postdoctoral position in the area of quantum information theory and quantum computation. Applicants with broader research interests are also encouraged to apply. The position is intended for someone with some postdoctoral experience but qualified applicants finishing their PhDs will also be considered. Successful applicants can start their appointment anytime between now and October 2006, and the duration of the award is 18-36 monthss.
